



Hancock/Adams Green & Downtown Construction Activities

Proposed work activities for the week of: July 23, 2017



- Staging continues for the next two weeks at the Granite Trust building. After the staging is erected, the building will undergo cleaning, waterproofing and repointing repairs which are expected to last into the fall.
- Windows are being installed at the Galvin building on the corner of Washington Street and McGrath Highway,
- Installation of the new drainage system will be taking place on Parkingway at Granite Street. Access may be limited at times on Monday and Tuesday to complete the drainage connection on the north end of this project.
- Demolition of the buildings at the future site of 1500 Hancock Street is $\frac{3}{4}$ complete.
